PISTOL CLINIC TO BE HOSTED BY FORMER OLYMPIAN

Former Olympic Free Pistol competitor and former US National Coach Arnie Vitarbo will be giving a clinic to improve your skills as a pistol shooter. The clinic will be held **Saturday 24 January** at the Naval Science Building at the U. It will begin with a classroom session at 0830 open to all interested shooters. On-range sessions will be limited by range capacity and available to the first to reply. Range sessions will focus on technical details of each of the Olympic pistol disciplines.

NRA INSTRUCTOR COURSE: BASIC PISTOL AND HOME FIREARMS SAFETY

There are still three seats available in the NRA Basic Pistol and Home Firearms Safety Instructor course to begin this Thursday, 22 January. Experienced pistol shooters can still enroll by requesting questionnaires and sending fired targets to Matt DeLong by noon on Wednesday, 21 January. Please RSVP immediately to Matt at 801-581-7462 or <u>delong@physics.utah.edu</u> There are two objectives: to train new instructors for the University marksmanship classes and to prepare people for a coaching course to be taught by Arnie Vitarbo in the spring.

The NRA's objective is to train instructors with the knowledge, skills and attitude to correctly and effectively teach Basic Pistol and Home Firearms Safety courses. It is their expectation that these instructors will come from a cadre of experienced shooters. The course will meet 22, 27 and 29 January, 2, 5, 10 and 12 February starting at 6:00 PM and lasting $2\frac{1}{2} - 3\frac{1}{2}$ hours. The cost will be

\$200 per person, to be fully refunded when new instructors have completed teaching two of the halfsemester marksmanship classes at the U. RSVP immediately if you want to get this training.

STATUS OF NEW RANGE CONSTRUCTION

We are beginning to enter into negotiations with the University on planning and construction of a very significant upgrade of the current shooting ranges on campus. Now we need your assistance with two things: (1) we need your input on design details for the new ranges and (2) we need your help with raising the money to pay for the construction and outfitting of these state-of-the-art facilities. Your assistance with fund raising takes on two forms: (1) tax-deductible cash (or in-kind) donations by you and (2) your suggestions on whom we can approach for donations. The second needs to be as detailed as possible, something like "I know Ferd Burfel who is a vice president of Acme Excavating and a strong supporter of shooting. I will ask him if they would be willing to donate the excavation." We all know that Larry Miller or Jon Huntsman could fund the operation in a heartbeat; the problem is that they get dozens of requests every day. We need contacts with access and sympathies. Think hard: this is the only way we are going to get funding. Naming rights typically go to a "cornerstone" or "anchor" donor who puts up something like 40% of the total cost.

This is our chance to have a real impact on the shooting sports in Utah for generations to come. Think big! We can help you with talking points when you make your pitch.

New Rules for PTOs hosted by UPMS

Since USA shooting is now posting shooter classifications (and national rankings) in a timely fashion (apparently after competitors have fired in three matches), individuals competing in UPMS PTOs will be required to enter their classifications on their entry cards to be eligible to win UPM\$. We will still keep track of shooters' scores for their first three matches and assign temporary classifications until official ones are issued by USAS.

To find your classification in each event, go to usashooting.org, log in and click on the "membership" tab at the top of the page. Scroll down a short distance to see your classification in

each event. Note that in accordance with USAS rules, if you have classifications in some event you may use the highest one in additional events until a classification is assigned in the new event you are taking up. Thank you for your assistance in making our match operations more efficient and accurate.
